LOS ANGELES, CA – December 20, 2019 – Little Fish Theatre's 2020 Season starts with **Pick of the Vine**, nine short plays highlighting what happens when options are weighed in the face of Big Decisions. The tastiest picks were plucked from over 670 submissions proffered from around the world. The annual audience and critics favorite opens January 16, featuring a mix of new and familiar LFT artists. The 17-member reading committee spent part of their summer reading their way through the sizeable stacks of short plays, choosing which scripts would then advance to the semi-final round where they were read aloud by LFT Company Members and scored. The top-scoring scripts chosen for production all include Big Decisions such as: a new and potentially dangerous way to pay off crushing college debt, choices being made inside today's classrooms, and whether to stay in a relationship when presented with new astrological consequences.

Last year's **Pick of the Vine** was awarded two "Scenies" from *StageScene LA*: Outstanding Ensemble in a Production of One-Acts and Outstanding Performance in a Production of One-Acts (Intimate Theatre).

Returning *Pick of the Vine* directors include LFT Company Members Holly Baker-Kreiswirth (*The Country House*, *Laughter on the 23rd Floor*) and James Rice (*The Cemetery Club, Plaza Suite*). New to the directing team are Sam Sintef, Assistant Director of *A Christmas Carol* at A Noise Within and a *Pick of the Vine* alumna; and Carly Pandza, founder and director of Her Theatre Company and director of *Swiped The Musical* which appeared at last year's Hollywood Fringe Festival.

LFT Company Members make up the cast: Melissa Booey (*Bloody Poetry*), Brad Light* (*Bus Stop*), and Branda Lock (*Dead Accounts*) make their debuts in *Pick of the Vine* with returning actors Ryan Knight (*Embridge*), Mary-Margaret Lewis* (*The Cemetery Club*), Susie McCarthy (*The Cemetery Club*), Olivia Schlueter-Corey (*Bloody Poetry*), and Perry Shields (*Pick of the Vine 2019*).



Stage Managing the show is Jacob Severance, with Set Design by Bill Wolski, Costume Design by Fatima Aleshaiker, Sound Design by Baker-Kreiswirth, and Prop Design by Grace Wolcott. Baker-Kreiswirth and Wolski produce.

Pick of the Vine will run at 8pm on Thursdays January 16 and 23, and February 6. Friday and Saturday nights at 8pm from January 17 through February 8. There will be four 2pm matinees: Sunday January 26, Sunday February 2, Saturday February 8, and Sunday February 9. An early evening show at 7pm has been added to the schedule on Sunday, February 2. The January 26 and February 8 matinees feature a special talkback session where audience members can interact with the cast and creative team.
